Contest Rules:

FORMAT

Original hand drawn. No clip art or premade images. **Electronically created posters will not be accepted.**

MUST use "Voters Rights" theme.

Text should be dark and large enough to read.

A variety of materials may be used, such as paint, pen and ink, crayon and markers, fabric.

Posters are to be created individually with a limit of one entry per person. Parents may offer advice but cannot aid in the creative process.

LAYOUT

Landscape Format Only

Dimensions

11" (h) X 14" (w)

CONTENT

Do not send any artwork that contains trademarked images or brands such as clipart, Disney Characters, Dell, Google, Twitter, and Facebook. Any entry that infringes upon copyright will not be judged.

Do not put any personal identifying information on the front of the poster.

Please be sure to include Name and Grade on back of poster.

ELIGIBILITY

Church of Christ at Eastside Youth

Grade level groups: K-2, 3-5, 6-8, and 9-12.

DEADLINE/SUBMISSION

All submissions are due no later than **Sunday, February 18 at 12:30 PM** (after morning service).

Posters should be turned in to Adriene McClarron, Francine Matthews or Janet Horace at the table in the foyer or in the library. They must be received by the deadline.

Posters will be displayed in the library or the foyer through February 25.

JUDGING

A panel of judges will select the winners in each age group based on these rules and criteria. The winning poster will be forwarded to the League of Women Voter Austin Local Poster Contest with winner consent.
